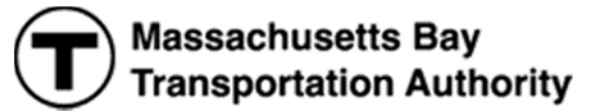


# MBTA Student Pass Program

## 2018-2019 Academic Year



Boston University Academy students are able to ride the T for a discounted rate either by using a **Student Stored Value CharlieCard** or by purchasing a **Student CharlieCard Pass**.

**Stored Value CharlieCard [S-Card]** FREE; enables a student to travel on the Bus, Subway, and Express Bus at a "Pay As You Go" half-fare rate

**CharlieCard Pass [M7 Pass]** \$30 per month; enables a student unlimited travel 7 days a week on the Bus, Subway, Express Bus, and Commuter Rail Zones 1A, 1, and 2

*CharlieCard monthly passes may be purchased upfront for the entire school year (September-June) or on a month-to-month basis.*

*Students are assigned one card for the year so it is imperative that it is not lost or misplaced. All M7 Pass and S-Card holders have the option to reload a monthly pass or funds to be used for "pay as you go" fares to their Student CharlieCard at any of the MBTA Fare Vending Machines for the months of July and August.*

Boston University Academy is easily accessible by public transportation. The following are the closest transit stops:

- SUBWAY** Green Line 'B' Train to BU Central Station (.2 mile)
- BUS** CT2 and 47 (in front of school), 57 (in front of GSU)
- COMMUTER RAIL** Framingham/Worcester Line to Yawkey Station (.6 mile)  
Other connections to the Green Line can be made at North Station, Park Street Station, or Back Bay Station via Copley Station
