

Lock-In 2019 FAQs: Friday, November 23-Saturday, November 24

What is Lock-In?

Lock-In is a giant overnight "sleep"-over event held at BUA and coordinated by Student Council. It is open to all current BUA students. Guests are not permitted at this event. There is no cost to the event.

When is Lock-In?

Lock-In will take place from Friday, November 23 at 7:00 p.m. to Saturday, November 24 at 7:00 a.m.

What happens during Lock-In?

All students must report to the lobby for the official check-in between 7:00-7:30 p.m. Once signed in, all students stay "locked-in" to the building except for chaperoned activities. There will be an outing for ice skating at the BU FitRec Center. Classrooms will be designated for different purposes (watching movies, playing games, dancing and even sleeping!) Parents and staff members will chaperone throughout the evening. The event ends at 7:00 a.m. on Saturday. A detailed schedule of events will be distributed a week prior to the event.

What is expected of students?

Students are expected to follow the rules and regulations as outlined in the Student Handbook throughout this event both on and off-campus. Specifically, students must respect the chaperones; keep the school clean; enter only areas designated for the evening; respect the property of others – the school, teachers, and fellow students; sign in and out when attending activities, and remain in the building unless participating in chaperoned activities.

What is provided and what should students bring?

There will be an ice cream social at the start of the event, pizza at midnight, and will end with a light breakfast on Saturday morning. We will reach out for donations from parents as well. Students may bring a pillow and sleeping bag. They are also encouraged to bring a refillable water bottle and to wear comfortable clothes.

How can parents help out?

Parents may volunteer to provide food and drink, to chaperone for all or part of the event, or to clean up in the morning. A sign-up sheet will be made available shortly. Thank you in advance for your help!
